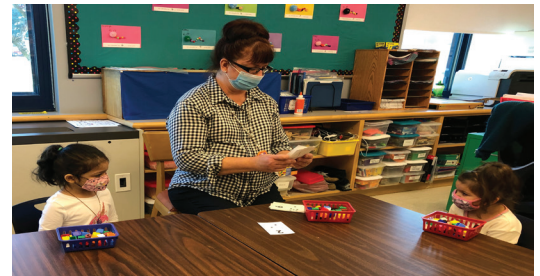
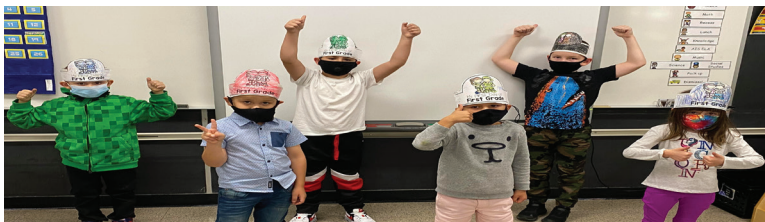

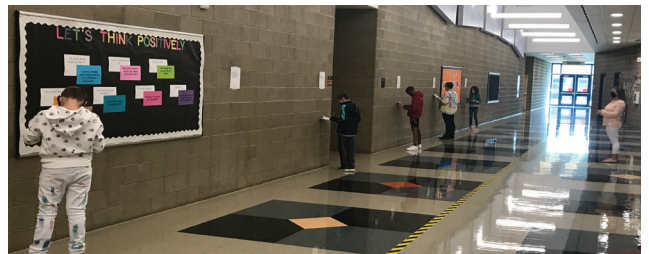
First Days at SES

This past spring semester was unlike no other. With the COVID-19 Pandemic, our staff and students quickly shifted gears to teach and learn remotely. The budget vote was by absentee ballot and passed. 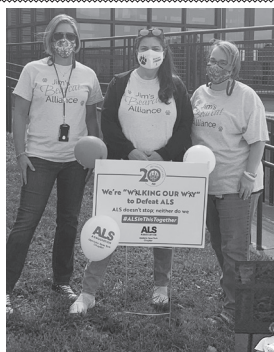
During the summer, administrators, teachers, staff, and community members created and successfully developed the District's Hybrid Reopening Plan. If you haven't activated your account, please do so so you can receive emails, text, and notifications.

Staff worked extremely hard to prepare and welcome students back to school both virtually and in-person. Cohort A comes to school on Mondays and Tuesdays while Cohort B comes on Thursdays and Fridays. Wednesdays is our virtual learning day for all students. Additionally on Wednesdays, families who have registered to receive meals are receiving their delivery via our transportation department.

After a well-informed decision, the District has postponed all fall sports to March 1, 2021 - Fall Season 2. After school programs will be offered soon through the 21st Century, BEST program.

Our capital project at Solvay High School is well underway and a considerable amount of work has been accomplished during the spring and summer. The new transportation facility was completed. Staff and buses moved back in and is fully operational. Phase 3 of the capital project will be at Solvay Elementary School beginning in 2021.
