(For the purchase of goods & services)

All Bids issued by the above named Solvay Union Free School District will bind Vendors and Successful Vendors to the conditions and requirements set forth in these General Conditions and any special conditions set forth herein (collectively, the "Conditions"), and such Conditions shall form an integral part of each Contract awarded by Solvay Union Free School District.

It is the Vendors' responsibility to read the following General Conditions, and the attached Detailed Instructions, Specifications and Bid which outline the bidding rules of Solvay Union Free School District.

Where the terms "bid" or "bids" are used in these documents, the bidder understands that the terms "proposal" or "proposals" could be used to replace "bid" or "bids" and be used interchangeably depending on the scope and nature of this solicitation.

DEFINITIONS

"School District"	The legal designation of the Solvay Union Free School District issuing this bid request.
"Notice to Bidders"	A formal statement which, when issued by the School District, constitutes a Solicitation for Bids on the products and/or services described by the Specifications.
"Board"	The Board of Education of the School District.
"Bid"	An offer to furnish products and/or services in accordance with the Notice to Bidders, the General Conditions, Detailed Instructions, Specifications, and Bid.
"Offer"	The form on which the Vendor submits a Proposal.
"Vendor"	Any individual, company, or corporation submitting a Bid.
"Contract"	A notice to the Successful Vendor by the issuance of a Purchase Order; also all documents relating to the transaction, including but not limited to: the Offer of the Successful Vendor, Notice to Bidders, General Information, General Conditions, Detailed Instructions, Specifications, Notice Of Award, Bid; also a formal document signed by the Successful Bidder and the School District/BOCES representative.
"Successful Vendor"	Any Vendor to whom an Award is made by the School District.
"Contractor"	Any Vendor to whom a Contract is made by the Board of Education.
"Specification"	Description of products and/or services and the conditions for its purchase.

- 1. The date, time, and place of Bid opening will be given in the Notice to Bidders.
- 2. All Bids must be submitted on the Bid Document and Bidder's Response Sheet included with this solicitation and in accordance with instructions provided by the Solvay Union Free School District.
- 3. All Bids received after the time stated in the Notice to Bidders will not be considered and will be returned unopened to the Vendor. The Vendor assumes the risk of any delay in the mail or in the handling of the mail by employees of Solvay Union Free School District. Whether sent by mail or by means of personal delivery, the Vendor assumes responsibility for having the Bid deposited on time at the place specified.
- 4. All information required by the Notice to Bidders, General Conditions, Special Conditions, Specifications, and Bid, in connection with each item against which a Bid is submitted, must be given to constitute a regular Bid.
- 5. The Non-Collusive Bidding Certification must be included with each Bid as required by General Municipal Law, section 103-d. The enclosed form "Bid Proposal Certifications" meets this requirement when signed and submitted as part of the bid response package.
- 6. The submission of a Bid will be construed to mean the Vendor is fully informed as to the extent and character of the products and/or services required and a representation that the Vendor can furnish the products and/or services satisfactorily in complete compliance with the Specifications.
- 7. Deviations from the bid specifications must be set forth in space provided on the Bidder's Exclusion Page and/or Bidder's Response Sheet for this purpose. The Solvay Union Free School District reserves the right to disqualify and reject any Vendor submission containing alterations by the Vendor. No alteration, erasure, or addition to the original bid documents will be permitted.
- 8. Prices and information required should be typewritten for legibility. Illegible or vague Bids may be rejected. All signatures must be written. Facsimile, printed, or typewritten signatures are not acceptable.
- 9. **Estimated Quantities**: The quantities for each Bid are indefinite, but estimates provided on the Bidder's Response Sheet reflect anticipated requirements. Quantities listed are estimates only. Actual quantities may be less or greater than listed. The Contract, however, shall be for the quantities actually ordered during the contract period. The Contractor must furnish all the quantities actually ordered.
- 10. Sales to participants are not affected by any fair trade agreements (General Business Law, sec. 369-a, sub. 3).
- 11. No charge will be allowed for Federal, State, or municipal sales and excise taxes that participants are exempt. Prices shall be net delivery location and shall not include the amount of any such taxes. Exemption certificates will be furnished directly by the participants.
- 12. **"Or Equal":** In all Specifications, the words "or equal" are understood after each article, or on any patented article. The decision of the BOCES as to whether an alternate or substitution is in fact "equal" shall be final. If Bids are submitted on items other than those specified, the Vendor must in every instance give the trade designation of the article, manufacturer's name, and detailed specifications of the item proposed to furnish. Otherwise, the Bid will be construed as submitted on the identical item as specified.
- 13. When Bids are requested on a total or aggregate basis, the expectation is that the Vendor bids on each item in the group. A Vendor deciding to submit a "no bid" on an item in a group must clearly indicate this; otherwise the entire Bid for the group may be rejected.
- 14. **Pricing**: Bid prices will remain firm for the contract period and are to be Free on Board (F.O.B) delivery location. Bid pricing must include all shipping, handling, freight, delivery, installation (unless otherwise indicated), hazardous materials handling fees, and other distribution charges to the participating "ship-to" locations. No additional charges will be allowed. A list of participating delivery locations is included with this bid package.

- 15. **There shall be NO minimum order amount:** Every effort will be made to encourage participants to group purchase orders to vendors to minimize the costs involved. Invoice shall be sent to each participant per the information on the purchase order.
- 16. The Vendor must insert the price per unit and the extensions, if applicable, against each item in the Bid. In the event of a discrepancy between the unit price and the extension, the unit price will govern. Prices shall be extended in decimals, not fractions.
- 17. All Bids must be sealed in a plain, opaque envelope provided by the responding vendor clearly marked "Bid" with the corresponding Bid number. Also the date and time of the Bid opening as indicated on the Notice to Bidders must appear on the envelope. Bids <u>must not</u> be attached to or enclosed in packages containing Bid samples. Faxed and/or e-mailed (electronically submitted) bids will <u>not</u> be accepted.
- 18. No interpretation of the meaning of the Specifications or other Contract Document will be made to any Vendor orally. Every request for such interpretation should be in writing, addressed to the Solvay Union Free School District, not later than five (5) days prior to the date fixed for the opening of Bids. Notice of any and all such interpretations and any supplemental instructions will be sent to all Vendors on record by the BOCES in the form of an Addendum to the Specifications. All Addenda so issued shall become part of the Contract Documents.
- 19. **Samples**: The Solvay Union Free School District reserves the right to request a representative sample products and/or services quoted upon either prior to the Award or before shipments are made. If the sample is not in accordance with the requirements of the Specification, the School District/BOCES may reject the Bid; or, if the Award has been made, cancel the Contract at the expense of the Successful Vendor.
- 20. **Award:** Awards will be made to the Lowest Responsible Vendor, as will best promote the public interest, taking into consideration the reliability of the Vendor, the quality of the products and/or services to be furnished, their conformity with Specifications, the purposes for which required, and the terms of delivery.
- 21. The participant reserves the right to cancel any or all items not delivered within 45 days of receipt of purchase orders (or a different time frame as indicated in the special conditions section).
- 22. **Rejection of Bids**: The BOCES reserves the right to reject any or all Bids. Also reserved is the right to reject, for cause, any Bid in whole or in part; to waive technical defects; qualifications, irregularities; and omissions if in its judgment the best interests of the participants will be served. Also reserved is the right to reject Bids and to purchase items on State or County Contracts if such items can be obtained on the same terms, conditions, specifications, and at a lower price.
- 23. The Solvay Union Free School District reserves the right to reject any and all Bids not deemed for the best interest of the participants and to reject as informal such Bids, as in the opinion, are incomplete, conditional, obscure, or which contain irregularities of any kind including unbalanced Bids. By an unbalanced Bid, it is meant one in which the amount submitted for one or more separate items is substantially out of line with current market prices for the products, services, materials and/or work covered thereby.
- 24. The Solvay Union Free School District reserves the right to make Awards within 60 days after the date of the Bid opening during which period Bids may not be withdrawn unless the Vendor distinctly states in the Bid that acceptance thereof must be made within a shorter specified time.
- 25. If two or more Vendors submit identical Bids as to price, the decision of the Board to award a Contract to one of such identical Vendors shall be final (General Municipal Law, sec. 103, sub. 1). Determination of the awarded vendor in an identical bid situation is made by a coin toss.
- 26. Each Bid will be received with the understanding that the acceptance thereof in writing by the Board, to furnish any or all of the products and/or services described therein shall constitute a Contract between the Successful Vendor and each individual participant. This Contract shall bind the Successful Vendor to furnish and deliver at the prices and in accordance with the conditions of the Bid. This Contract shall bind the participant to pay for at the Contract prices, all products and/or services ordered and delivered.

- 27. Vendors should ensure accuracy in figures <u>prior to</u> submission. If a Vendor discovers a mistake in an item in their Bid award and wants that item award rescinded after it has been Awarded, the Solvay Union Free School District reserves the right to rescind the entire award and the Vendor's responsibility may be questioned for future Bids.
- 28. Notification by mail or electronically of a Notice of Award or Purchase Order to a Successful Vendor, to the contact information given in the Bid, will be considered sufficient notice of acceptance of Contract.
- 29. Any and all Awards resulting from this Bid shall be final and shall be for the complete term of the Contract. No rescinding of Awards will be made because of Vendor error or inability to supply a product and/or service.
- 30. The Successful Vendor is responsible for reviewing the Notice of Award or Purchase Order for errors. Any clerical errors in the Award must be forwarded, in writing, to the Office of the Assistant Superintendent for Business within five (5) working days of the Notification of Award. No corrections will be made beyond that date. If clerical errors discovered are too late to be corrected, a "no award" will be issued on those affected products and/or services. The products and/or services will be re-bid or quoted at a later date.
- 31. A Contract may be cancelled at the Successful Vendor's expense upon non-performance of Contract.
- 32. Cancellation of Contract for any reason may result in removal of the Successful Vendor's name from mailing list for future Bids for an indefinite period.
- 33. It is mutually understood and agreed that the Successful Vendor shall not assign, transfer, convey, sublet, or otherwise dispose of the Contract or the right, title, or interest therein, or the power to execute such Contract, to any other person, company, or corporation, without the previous written consent of the Solvay Union Free School District.
- 34. If the Successful Vendor is not able to provide the awarded goods and/or services under the conditions specified, the Solvay Union Free School District reserves the right to obtain the goods and services from an alternate vendor and the Successful Vendor will pay any difference in cost between the awarded bid price and the cost of obtaining the goods and/or services from the alternate vendor.
- 35. **Insurance**: The Successful Vendor guarantees to carry adequate insurance to protect the participants from loss in case of accident, fire, theft, etc. Vendors shall maintain adequate insurance to protect them from all claims under the Workers' Compensation Act. If requested, a Certificate of Insurance shall be submitted verifying Liability and Commercial Automobile Insurance coverage.
- 36. Payment will be made only after correct presentation of claim forms or invoices as may be required.
- 37. The Successful Vendor shall not be held responsible for any losses resulting if the fulfillment of the terms of the Contract shall be delayed or prevented by wars, acts of public enemies, strikes, fires, floods, acts of God, or for any other acts not within the control of the Successful Vendor and which by the exercise of reasonable diligence is unable to prevent.
- 38. In addition to the General Conditions, the following Special Conditions & specifications listed below and on the "Bidders Response Sheet" must also be met. Where applicable, the Special Conditions will supersede the General Conditions.
- 39. **Non-Funding Termination**: The Solvay Union Free School District shall have the right to terminate individual orders without further obligation as of the end of the then current fiscal year in the event that Solvay Union Free School District fails to get a budgetary appropriation for the continuation of individual orders for any subsequent fiscal year. Solvay Union Free School District shall give bidder written notice of termination at least sixty (60) days prior to the end of the then current fiscal year. This contract shall be deemed executor only to the extent of the monies appropriated and available for the purpose of the contract, and no liability on account thereof shall be incurred by the purchaser beyond the amount of such monies. It is understood that neither this contract nor any legal or moral obligation to request, appropriate or make available monies for the purpose of this contract.
- 40. **Complaints**: Both participants and vendors will submit all complaints in writing to the appropriate party(s) within four (4) days of any occurrence. The Solvay Union Free School District Purchasing Office will maintain a file of all complaints that are submitted from both the vendor and Solvay Union Free School District.

- 41. **Buy Against Clause:** Vendors will be afforded the chance to first rectify any complaint, concern or issue brought to them by a participant. When resolution of an issue is not imminent or poses a perceived risk to participant's property or the health and safety of its staff and/or students, participants may immediately purchase products in the open market if the awarded bidder fails to deliver within the time specified, or fails to make replacements of items deemed unacceptable by the participating district. Participants reserve the right to authorize immediate purchase from other sources against late deliveries and rejections on any contract when necessary. On all such purchases the successful bidder(s) agrees to reimburse the participant promptly, or deduct from the participant's current balance owed, if applicable, for excess cost occasioned by such purchases. Should the cost be less, the successful bidder shall have no claim to the difference.
- 42. **Material Data Safety Sheets (MSDS):** Material Data Safety Sheets must accompany every shipment for all items having an established MSDS, as set forth by the New York State Right to Know Law enacted in 1970, and the Federal Hazard Communications Standard enacted in 1983. Vendors not supplying MSDS sheets may be declared an unresponsive bidder for future bids.
- 43. **Delivery:** Delivery shall be made in accordance with the instructions as listed on the purchase order from each participant. Delivery times and frequencies will be made as agreed upon in advance between the participant and/or their designee and the vendor representative. .
- 44. **Credit Terms**: Each participant will make payment according to their established payment terms and policies. All delivery and billing related concerns should be addressed to the participant. If it becomes necessary for a vendor to discontinue deliveries for non-payment, the participant must be notified at least fifteen (15) days in advance of such discontinuance. The vendor will also provide the-participant with a detailed description of the circumstances and reasons for pursuing this course of action.
- 45. Bids on equipment must be on standard new equipment of latest model, and in current production unless otherwise specified.
- 46. If it is determined that the vendor is distributing items, that in the opinion of the Solvay Union Free School District are identified as outdated, non-conforming to the item specifications, or creates the potential for health or injury risk, the Solvay Union Free School District reserves the right, if necessary, to address such issues with the vendor and take appropriate action including, but not limited to, vendor disqualification for those particular item(s).
- 47. Vendor(s) providing goods or services that do not conform with the specifications provided, or in the case of an alternate item award, to the description indicated by the vendor, may be rejected and returned at vendor's risk and expense. Items returned to the vendor will be purchased elsewhere and the excess cost will be charged to the vendor. .
- 48. **Sale Items**: When a bid item appears on a company sales flyer or their website at a lower price, the lower price will apply to all bid participants. .
- 49. **Extension**: Solvay Union Free School District reserves the right to extend the terms and conditions of this proposal for a period no greater than one (1) year; not to exceed four (4) years from original date of award, upon mutual consent of the BOCES and the awarded vendor(s).
- 50. Termination of the contract can be made on the anniversary date of the bid award by either the vendor or Solvay Union Free School District upon 30 day written notice. - 51. Any exception(s) listed on the Bidders Exclusions page will be identified, reviewed, and taken into consideration by Solvay Union Free School District as part of the bid award process, and/or for purposes of determining that vendor's ability to serve bid participants in a responsible manner.
- 52.
