Notification of Group Assignments will be made as soon as possible



#### Masks

All students and staff must wear face coverings whenever possible



#### Hand Hygiene

Hand washing will be encouraged multiple times a day. In addition, sanitizer stations will be available for use.



#### Physical Distancing

Six foot distancing will be maintained when possible



#### Cleaning

Facilities will be cleaned and disinfected following CDC Guidelines



#### Water Bottles

Students should bring their own water bottles (labeled with their name). Touchless refillable stations will be available



#### Stay Home if Sick

Families will screen children daily and keep them home if they display COVID symptoms or are ill. Students must be picked up from school if they are symptomatic

# Changes to the School Environment

## Classrooms

- ◆ Student Desks and seats will face in the same direction in the classroom
- ◆ As possible, students will not share equipment or supplies. Shared items will be sanitized frequently
- ◆ Desks/tables will be disinfected after each class transition
- ◆ Dividers will be provided as needed to create physical barriers in classrooms where tables are used for seating
- ◆ Schedules will be reconfigured when possible to limit student movement.

## Cafeterias

- ◆ Students will be prohibited from sharing food
- ◆ Seating will be adjusted to facilitate 6 foot physical distancing
- ◆ Face coverings/masks will be required until students are seated
- ◆ Outside food may not be delivered for students
- ◆ No visitors for lunch



## Playgrounds

- ◆ Outdoor recess will be staggered and will comply with physical distancing requirements
- ◆ Equipment will be cleaned on a frequent basis
- ◆ Students will be encouraged to participate in touch free activities such as jumping rope, hopscotch, and running



## School Buses

- ◆ Students will wear masks while on school buses
- ◆ Buses will be cleaned and sanitized between runs
- ◆ Dismissal will be staggered to maintain appropriate distancing

## Other Preventative Measures

- ◆ Barriers will be installed as needed in buildings
- ◆ Each school will designate entry points for staff and students. Students will be dismissed in small groups to bus, car, or walk at the end of the school day
- ◆ Schools will stagger transition times to aid in physical distancing. Congregating in the hallways between classes will not be allowed
- ◆ Visitors/guests will be limited
- ◆ Facility use by outside groups will be limited
- ◆ Families are encouraged to provide their own transportation to reduce bus ridership
