Dear Solvay Parents and Guardians of Students 16+,

Our partners at Onondaga County are making it possible for high school students, ages 16 and older, to receive the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine, during school hours. We are happy to report that Onondaga County officials have organized a westside Pfizer COVID-19 school vaccine clinic, which will be held on April 29, 2021, from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. at West Genesee High School. The required follow-up vaccination will take place on May 20, 2021, from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. at West Genesee High School.

Transportation from Solvay High School to West Genesee High School will be provided. However, if parents wish to transport and accompany their child, they are welcome to do so.

If you completed the vaccination interest survey sent previously by the district and indicated you were interested in having your child receive the vaccine, Onondaga County will send you the sign-up information directly via email.

You may also sign up your child (must be 16 years old or older) directly using this link, even if you did not respond to the previous interest survey.

On the day of the vaccination, students must have the following with them to receive the vaccine:

- A printed, <u>completed consent form</u>. Each student must have the form <u>signed by a parent/guardian</u>. (Note: a consent form will also be required for the follow-up appointment that will automatically be created for Thursday, May 20, 2021. All of the details are the same.)
- 2. A picture identification card (driver's license, school ID, etc.)
- 3. Fill out this <u>required New York State form</u> prior to getting this vaccine.

If a family member also wishes to receive the vaccine, they can schedule an appointment using the <u>same link</u>. The same forms must also be completed for each individual and presented at the time of the appointment. Family members and/or remote students will need to arrive at West Genesee High School using the main entrance circle, entering through the upper gymnasium entrance (Entrance X). This vaccine is given free of charge even though you will have to enter insurance information when you sign up.

Thank you in advance for your cooperation in helping to get our eligible students vaccinated.
