Code 15 Professional Salaries	Professional Salaries will be used to pay teachers for out of contractual work hours at an hourly rate for work related to the following: support of character development program at middle school; middle school teachers to identify and implement a new universal benchmarking assessment at the middle school; the identification and implementation of new math curriculum materials for K-8; training related to evidence-based practice for teaching reading; and training of staff in <u>Youth Mental Health First Aide</u> . The YMFA training is an evidence based training that helps adults identify mental health struggles, including signs of suicide and teaches them how to support the student and connect the student with appropriate help. Providing this training to teachers and other staff members will increase the likelihood that someone will notice and respond appropriately to a student that is experiencing significant mental health struggles. The COVID-19 pandemic has increased the strain on people's mental health.
	Additionally, expenditures in this category are associated with the salary to add an additional special education teacher to increase the districts support of special education students. An ENL teacher will be added to provide more support to our K-4 ENL students. A building substitute for each building will be hired full time to support the sub shortage issues.

This person will also help with contact tracing. A person will be hired to conduct the weekly required COVID-19 testing for unvaccinated staff.
