The in-school model fosters early recognition of mental health needs and promotes an atmosphere that recognizes the interconnectedness between education and mental health.
Promise Zone Specialists <i>CCSI</i>	Jes Sudol TBD Kadjah Thomas	SES SMS SHS	Promise Zone is a school-based mental health program that matches students' emotional and behavioral needs with effective, targeted interventions designed to develop skills and increase engagement in instructional time through a multi-tiered system of support. This program is managed by Coordinated Care Services Inc., on behalf of Onondaga County, Department of Children and Family Services, Division of School Based Initiatives.

The SEL Interventionist will support students' social-emotional health and development. Partners with teachers to develop strategies for student success.
