

**NOTICE OF SPECIAL SCHOOL DISTRICT
MEETING OF THE VOTERS OF THE
SOLVAY UNION FREE SCHOOL DISTRICT**

THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE SOLVAY UNION FREE SCHOOL DISTRICT HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that pursuant to a Resolution adopted by the Board of Education of the District on October 21, 2024, a special meeting of the qualified voters of said Solvay Union Free School District in the County of Onondaga, State of New York, will be held in the Solvay High School Aux Gym, 600 Gertrude Ave, Solvay, New York 13209 on December 10, 2024 from 12:00 P.M. to 9:00 P.M. prevailing time, for the purpose of voting upon the following proposition:

PROPOSITION

Shall the Board of Education undertake a project consisting of reconstruction, renovation, and construction of improvements and upgrades to the High School, Middle School, Elementary School and Transportation Center, including, but not limited to, interior and exterior renovations and improvements, mechanical upgrades, High School track improvements, site improvements and drainage, pavement and sidewalk improvements, original furnishings, fixtures and equipment, architectural fees, and all other costs incidental to such work at a total estimated cost not to exceed \$5,250,000 and obtain the necessary funds by using up to \$950,000 from the Capital Reserve and, for the balance, the levy of a tax in the amount of \$4,300,000 upon the taxable property of the District to be collected in annual installments in the years and in the amounts as the Board of Education shall determine and in anticipation of such tax bonds and notes of the District are hereby authorized to be issued at one time, or from time to time, in the principal amount not to exceed \$4,300,000, and a tax is hereby voted to pay the interest on said obligations when due.

NOTICE IS GIVEN that voting upon the foregoing Proposition will be by paper ballot or voting machine and will take place on December 10, 2024 in the Solvay High School Aux Gym, 600 Gertrude Ave, Solvay, New York 13209 from 12:00 noon to 9:00 P.M. prevailing time.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that qualified voters may obtain applications for an absentee ballot or early voting ballot from the office of the Clerk of the District. Completed applications for an absentee ballot or early voting ballot must be received by the District Clerk of the District no later than 4:00 P.M. prevailing time, on December 9, 2024 and must be received no later than 4:00 P.M. prevailing time, on December 3, 2024 if the absentee ballot or early voting ballot to be mailed to the voter. Completed applications received after 4:00 P.M. on December 3, 2024, will require the voter to personally appear at the Office of the Clerk of the District to receive an absentee ballot or early voting ballot. A listing of all persons to whom an absentee ballot or early voting ballot is issued will be available for inspection by any qualified voter in the Office of the Clerk of the District between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. during each of the five (5) business days prior to the election.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that military ballots may be applied for by qualified voters by requesting an application from the Deputy District Clerk at (315) 468-1111, option 7 or acronklin@solvayschools.org. Completed applications for military ballots must be received by the

District Clerk no later than 4:00 P.M. on November 14, 2024. In a request for a military ballot application or ballot, the military voter may indicate their preference for receiving the application or ballot by mail, facsimile transmission or electronic mail.
