Scope of the Capital Project

Solvay High School

- Replace main entrance and cafeteria entrance doors
- Replace air handling units on roof
- Replace original elevator
- Replace remaining sidewalks
- Replace site lighting at bus loop and main parking lot
- Reconstruct track including new surfacing and fencing
- Replace stadium lighting and scoreboard, and add pathway lighting

Solvay Middle School

- Replace student entrance doors near cafeteria

Solvay Elementary School

- Replace main entrance doors
- Replace main office air handling unit

Transportation Center

- Electrical upgrades

How much will the Capital Project cost the district?

- Total Project Cost: \$5,250,000
- NYS Building Aid: \$4,300,000 (82%)
- Capital Reserve: \$950,000 (18%)
- **No Anticipated Tax Impact**

Will Absentee Ballots be available?

Yes. Qualified voters may obtain applications for absentee ballots from the office of the School District Clerk. Completed applications for absentee ballots must be received by the District Clerk no later than Dec. 3, 2024 if the absentee ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or Dec. 9, 2024 if the ballot is to be personally delivered to the voter. A listing of all persons to whom an absentee ballot is issued will be available for inspection by any qualified voter during regular business hours in the Office of the Clerk of the School District through Dec. 9, 2024. Additional information on absentee ballots can be obtained by calling the District Office, at (315) 468-1111, option 7.

Am I eligible to vote?

To vote, you must meet the following criteria:

Be a citizen of the United States

Be at least 18 years of age

Be a legal resident of the Solvay UFSD for at least 30 days prior to Dec. 10, 2024
