What's Going On 2017-2018...

- Administrative shift (Chris Miczan to SES, Cole Blossey as Dean)
- Scheduling
 - ELA 6 -- 1 period to 1.5 periods Instructional Time
 - Added HS credit course in the Technology Department
 - 3 lunch periods instead of 2 including Recess for all grade levels
 - Review of student enrollment in Biology and Algebra 1 (Regents)
- Student Management
 - Clear expectations, consistent discipline
- BSLT/SLT (Site Based Leadership Team)
 - Building-Wide input on issues/initiatives

- Added ARISE Caseworker (serving approx. 15+ students)

Our Students (Demographics)

- Data represents March 5, 2019 reporting date
 - [Reporting date 3/05/2018 in brackets]
- ► Total Population = 472 students [459]
- American Indian or Alaskan Native = 7 (1%) [4]
- Asian = 0 [2]
- ▶ Black or African American = 33 (7%) [23]
- Hispanic = 46 (10%) [38]
- ► Multiple Races = 45(10%) [51]
- Native Hawaiian/Other Pacific Islander = 0 [0]
- ▶ White = 341 (72%) [341]

- Female = 225 (48%) [226]
- Male = 247 (52%) [233]
- ► IEP = 68 (14%) [62]
- > 504 Plan = 15 (3%) [19]
- ► + BOCES DHH = 9 [5]

Our Students (Economically Disadvantaged)

Data represents April 2019 reporting date from Solvay UFSD Food Services Department

- ► Total Population = 472 students
- Pre-K (60 students) = 35 (58%)
- \rightarrow 5 8 (412 students) = 284 students (68%)
- ► Total Free and Reduced = 319 students (68%)

Student Disciplinary Incidents (%)

- Total = 1632 (March 2019 data)
- ► Tardy to School = 19%
- Classroom Policy Violations/Disruptions = 10%
- Disrespectful Behavior = 8%
- Cut Scheduled Detention = 8%
- Insubordination = 8%
- Profanity = 7%
- ► Cut Class = 7%

- ► Inappropriate Physical Contact = 4%
- ▶ Left Class w/o Permission= 4%
- Rescheduled due to Absence = 3%
- ► Dress Code = 2%
- Cafeteria Violation = 2%
- ► Cell Phone Violation = 2%
- Other (less than 2%) = 16%

What's Going On Next 2019-2020...

- Administrative shift again! (Assistant Principal)
- Scheduling
 - Math 6 -- 1 period to 1.5 periods Instructional Time
 - Shift Special Education Co-Teaching 7-8 ELA/Math to 15:1 (to allow for better handling of accommodations and more focused instruction based on need)
 - Based on positive feedback, Recess will continue
- Student Achievement
 - PTO sponsored events for High Achievement
 - Work w/Content Specialists toward richer instruction and improved outcomes

- Increase Social and Emotional Learning [SEL] Skill Instruction
