Parents and Students,

Welcome to 5th Grade! As we enter this new school year I have attached different forms to help our school year start off smoothly and to assist me in better taking care of our students.

A few reminders:

- NYS requires a physical examination to be completed for all students entering 5th grade. These can be brought into school with your child or faxed into the school.
- NYS requires all 5th grade students to have a health screening completed.
 - This includes: hearing and vision screening for males with the addition of a scoliosis screening for females. This can be completed by your physician or throughout the school year by the school nurse. An opt out form is in this packet if you do not wish the school nurse to complete this screening.
- Any medications must have a note from a doctor and parent permission form for students to take on the school premises.
 - This includes: Inhalers, Epi-pens, benadryl, cough drops, tylenol, ibuprofen, any lotions that are medicated (hydrocortisone), allergy relief medications and any other substances OTC or prescription that a student has to take or needs during school hours. If a student takes medication at school without an order this will result in a 5 day suspension and a superintendent hearing.
